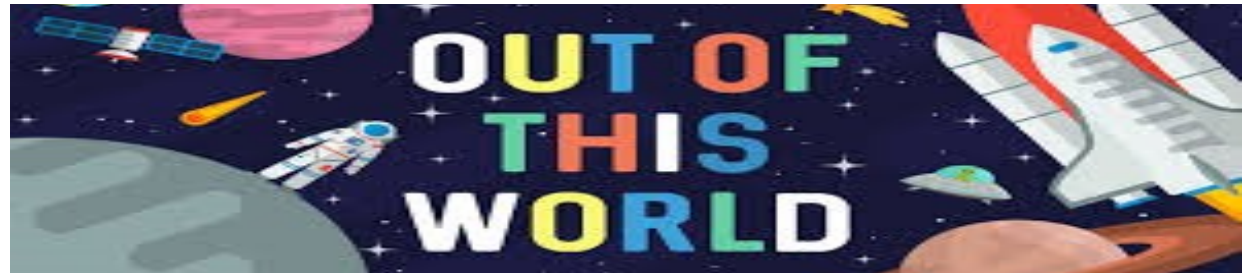


Key Vocabulary

- **Space**— the physical universe beyond the earth's atmosphere.
- **Planet**— a celestial object moving in an elliptical orbit round a star.
- **Solar System**— the collection of eight planets and their moons in orbit round the sun.
- **Astronaut**— a person who is trained to travel in a spacecraft.
- **Moon Landing**— the first time humans stepped on the surface of the moon, 20th July 1969.
- **NASA**— National Aeronautics and Space Administration.
- **Space Station**— a large artificial satellite used as long-term base for manned operations in space.
- **Spacecraft**— a vehicle or machine designed to fly in outer space.
