

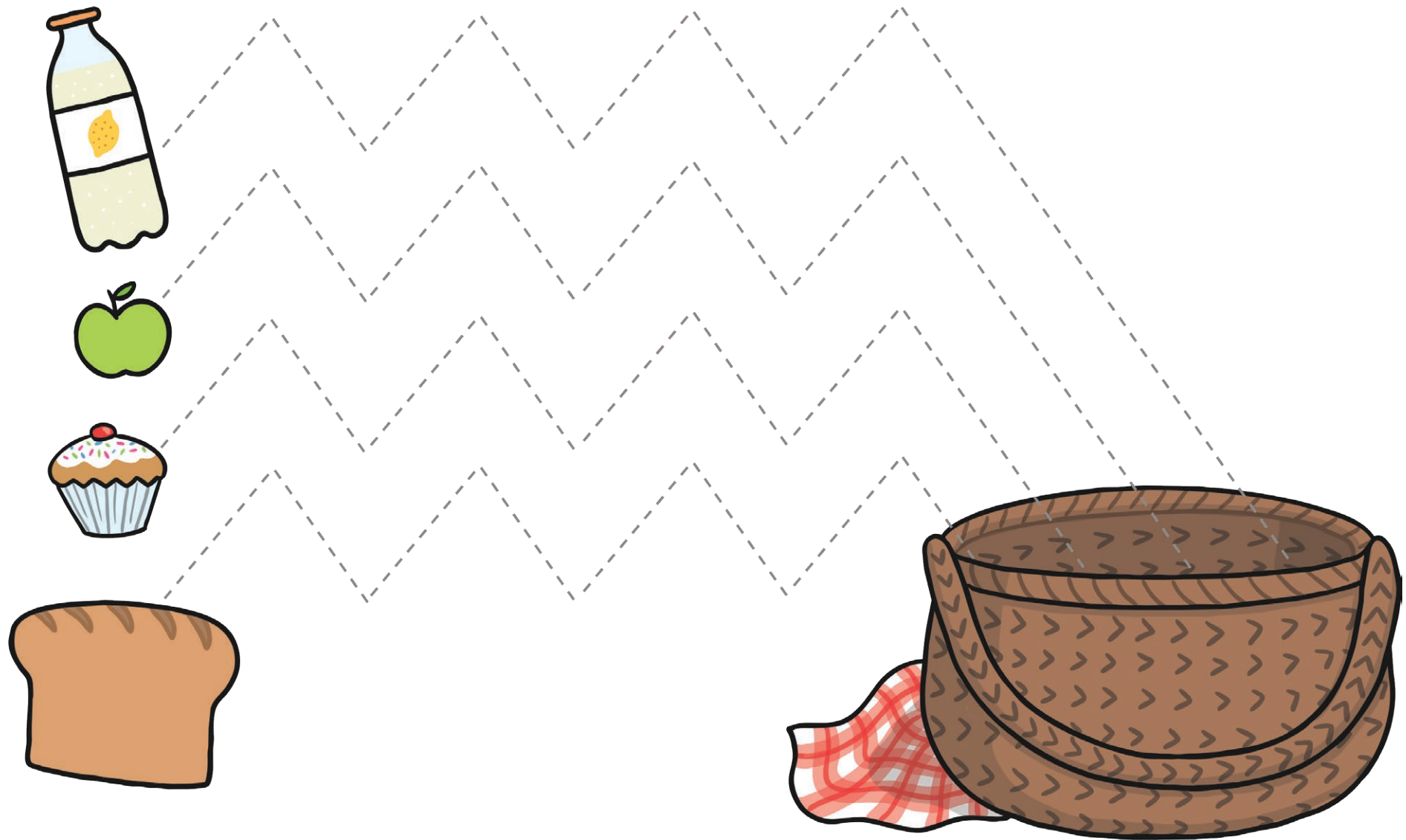


Little Red Riding Hood got out of bed one morning and got ready.



Once she had dressed, she headed to the kitchen to have some breakfast.

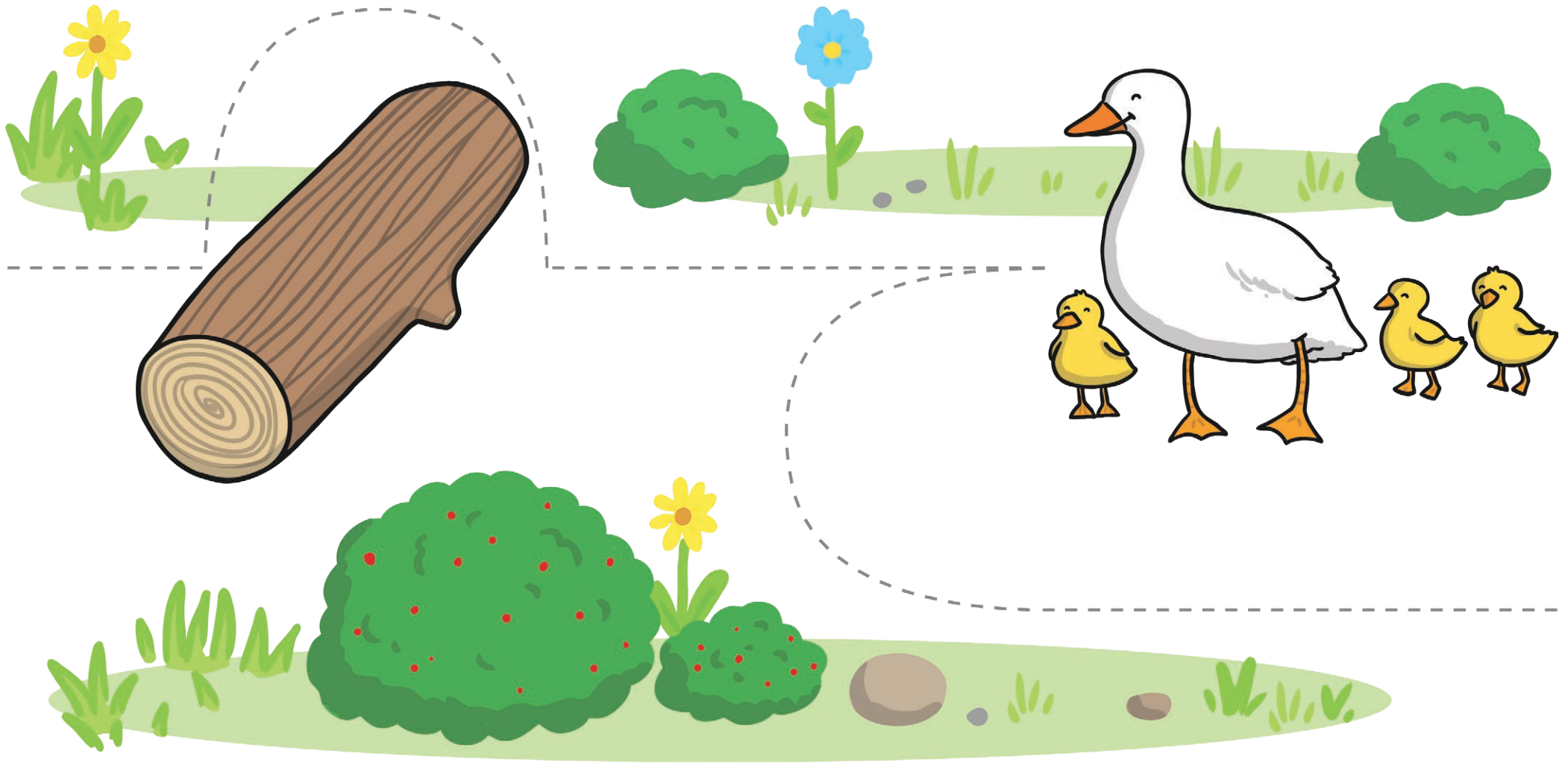
Little Red Riding Hood filled her basket full of tasty treats to take to her grandmother's house in the woods.

On her way, she jumped over a fallen log and around some ducks crossing the path.



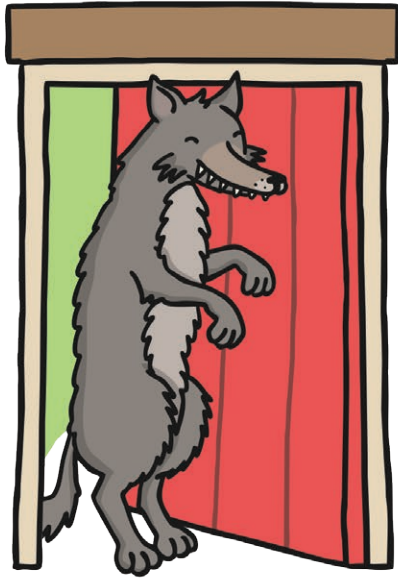
Around the bend, Little Red Riding Hood met a wolf on the path.
“Hello, where are you going to?” he said.



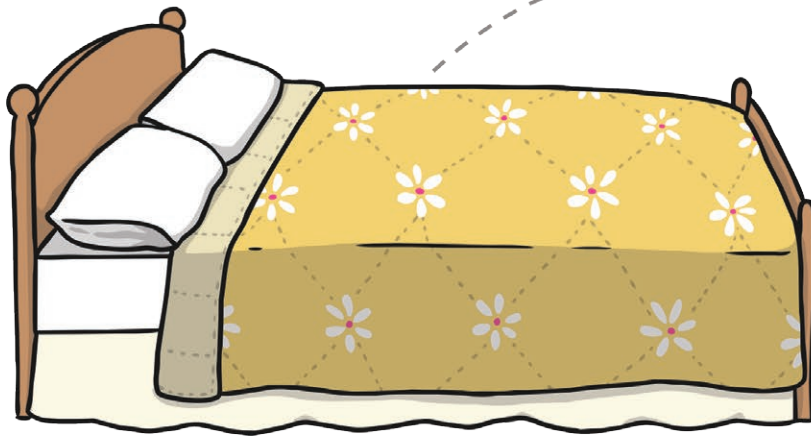
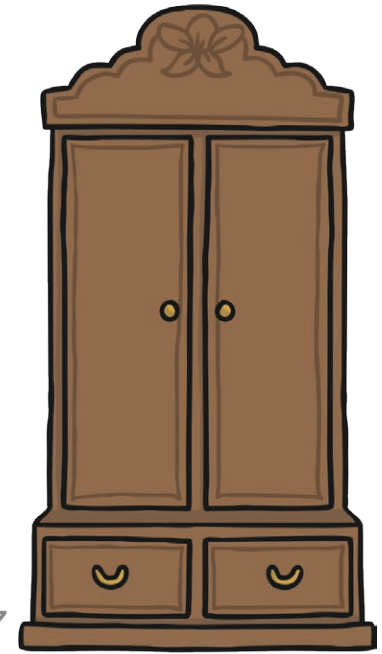
“I am going to visit my grandmother’s house in the woods,” she replied.

Little Red Riding Hood went to see her grandmother in bed.

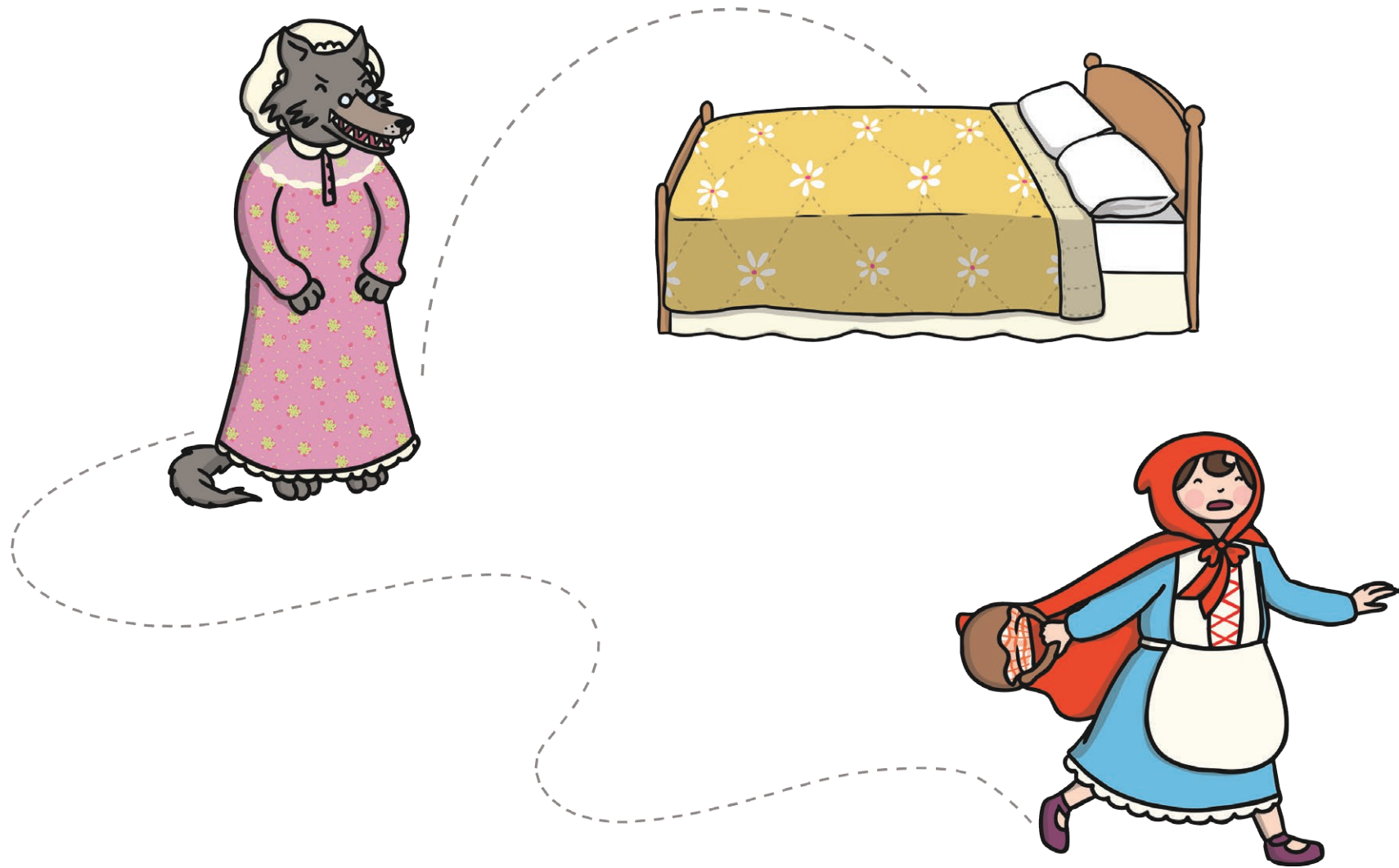
“What big ears you have!” she said.
