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Phonics

## Maths

National Oak follows the Maths Mastery scheme which we also use in school, meaning the lessons are extremely similar to those we would usually teach.

This week we are continuing with grouping and sorting. There will be a live lesson on Monday to recap and consolidate last week's lessons.

## Literacy

<u>Monday</u>- Today we are making predictions about what we think happened to the dinosaurs. Watch my video to see everybody's ideas, then have a go at writing your own prediction.

<u>Wednesday-</u> Now it's time to actually find out what happened to the dinosaurs! There is a fun video to watch, a little sequencing game, and then the children's task for today is to tell somebody all about what happened, using ordinal language (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, last etc) and our star words (extinct/extinction, meteor/asteroid).

<u>Friday</u>. As it's the last day we are having a nice fun lesson. We will be reading Diggory Digger and the Dinosaurs and then children's task is to design their own dinosaur!

## PE

This week we are looking at the train theme for PE. Click EYFS/KS1 and then click the picture of the train. Work your way through the sections. On the games section, this week's game is Wobbly Bridge. You only need to play one game as we will be doing the other games in the following weeks.
