Belonging



Baptism enables people to belong to God's family in a special way. Christians believe that everyone is invited to share in the life and work of God through Baptism.

Know and understand:

- **Explore** About belonging to different groups
- Reveal—That Baptism is an invitation to belong to God's family
- **Respond** Wonder about our world; God gave us this wonderful world.

Our Big Question:

Questions for meaning and purpose:

How can I belong to God?

What does it feel like to belong?

Talk about their experience and feelings about belonging to different groups.

Wonder about belonging and what that means.

Recognise and use some religious words and phrases used in Baptism, such as 'I baptise you in the name of the Father...'

Recognise that Baptism is the beginning of life in the Church family.

 $\boldsymbol{\mathsf{Ask}}$ and $\boldsymbol{\mathsf{respond}}$ to questions about their own and others experiences of belonging to different groups.

Ask questions about what they and others wonder about Baptism and becoming a Christian and realise some of these are difficult to answer.

Use religious words and phrases to begin to describe some actions and symbols used in a Baptism ritual such as pouring of water, anointing with oil, lighting the baptismal candle etc.
