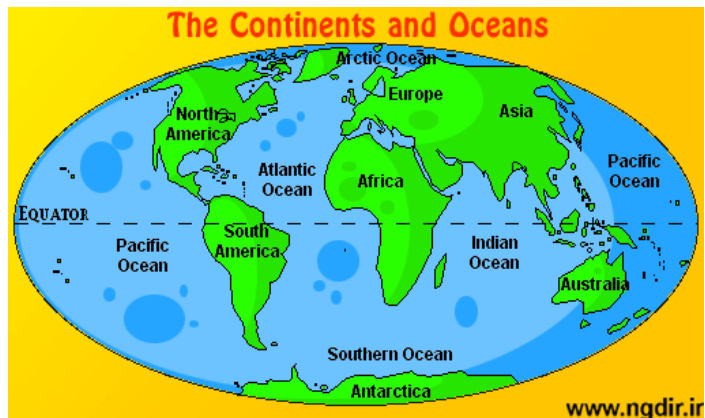


Key Vocabulary

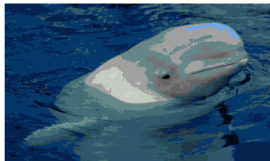
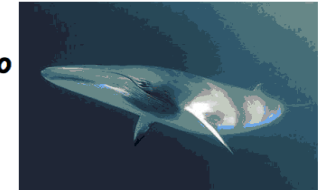
whale tales

Whales are mammals who live in the ocean. The blue whale is the biggest animal on earth at almost 100 feet long.



Whales are carnivores. They eat fish, sea creatures like seals, squid, krill and even other whales.

Whales breathe air through their blowholes. They can live a long time, even up to 90 years old. Whales don't sleep like people, but instead take quick naps. There are 75 different kinds of whales.
