

Homework Challenge Grid - Year 3 Spring Term 2023

Reading

Read aloud to your parents for 10 minutes each evening. Remember to summarise what has happened so for and talk about features of the book that you may have had experience of, or that interested you.

Challenge 1 The Iron Man

Use craft materials to make your own robot model... or could you make a life-sized robot?

Times tables

You need to be able to recall Times table facts quickly 2,3,4 5, 8 & 10. Try them backwards as well

Use websites <u>Hit the Button</u> and <u>TimesTables Rockstars</u> to help you practice

Challenge 2 The Iron Man

Think about the properties of different materials. What might have happened if the 'Iron Man' was made of wood, plastic, fabric or jelly? Plan an experiment to test the strength of different materials.

Spellings

Practise the words on your spelling zapper grid. When you feel you are ready, you (or grandparents, older siblings...) can check you can spell the words correctly. Each time a word is spelt correctly a small 'z' is put in the corner of that rectangle.

Challenge 3

Create your own version of 'The Iron Man' and write a detailed character description.

Ideas to include:

- What is their name?
- What material are they made from?
- How tall are they?
- What do they like to eat? What are their strengths and weaknesses?
- How could you describe their... Face -> eyes, nose, mouth and ears. Body -> arms, legs, hands, feet, clothes, etc

Handwriting

Copy out a paragraph of your book in cursive script. Why not cover two tasks at the same time and write your spellings in cursive script?

Challenge 4

What do the virtues 'Faith' and 'Simplicity' mean to you? Draw what comes into your mind when you think about these virtues.

Animation Challenge
